## Course Overview

Hindi 2 introduces students to the language and culture of India and Hindi speaking parts of the world. The overall goal is to develop functional communicative abilities in students to express basic communication needs in culturally appropriate ways. The skills of speaking, listening, reading and writing will be attained by students through exposure to rich authentic linguistic and cultural teaching contexts that emphasize students' developing competency in Hindi language and culture.

The course objectives include developing communication skills and understanding various aspects of culture through exposure to cultural activities that provide each student an opportunity to enhance language learning in appropriate cultural contexts. These activities include Hindi media, discussion of important Indian and American events, and field trips to live Hindi plays, Bollywood movies, and other local traditional ethnic cultural activities that will familiarize students with perspectives, practices and products of Hindi speaking regions of the world.

## Course Content

The course content for Hindi 2 is grouped in 3 units.

### **Unit 1: Past Connections**

This unit focuses on describing past events and circumstances using oblique forms with expressions of time, narrating stories and events, and sharing experiences and accomplishments.

### **Unit 2: Making Travel Plans and Arrangements**

This unit focuses on making definite and possible plans, giving directions, following directions, arranging transportation and lodging, and learning about geography.

### **Units 3: Rules and Responsibilities**

This unit introduces students to expressions of compulsion, giving instructions and following instructions.

- To narrate a story or past experience or accomplishments in writing and/or verbally.
- To follow directions to find a geographical location.
- To make possible and/or definite travel plans and lodging arrangements.
